The present application has been filed seeking the condonation of delay of 142 days in filing the review application.

No justification has come as to why, the delay has occurred in filing the present application.

As per the settled principle of law, each delay has to be explained. Further, the order against which the review is being sought to be filed, was passed in the presence of the parties concerned, hence, it cannot be said that the said order was not to the knowledge of the review applicant.

Apart from this, the order sought to be reviewed was passed in the open Court on the request of the learned counsel for the review petitioners, which fact has not been denied even during the course of hearing of the review application.
