Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (*for short 'Cr.P.C.'*), *inter alia*, for quashing the following impugned order(s)/judgment(s):-

- (i) order dated 12.05.2023 (P-14), passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Samrala, whereby application (P-12) of the petitioner, moved under Section 239 Cr.P.C. for discharge, has been rejected;
- (ii) order/judgment dated 16.08.2023 (P-16), passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana, whereby criminal revision of the petitioner against the aforesaid order (P-14) was partly rejected; and

(iii) order dated 18.08.2023 (P-17), passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Samrala, whereby petitioner was charge-sheeted under Sections 467 & 200 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

(2) After hearing at length, when this Court was not inclined to accept the prayer, learned Counsel for the petitioner (who is present in person), on instructions, wishes to withdraw the main petition with liberty to raise all her pleas before learned trial Court at appropriate stage(s).

(3) Ordered accordingly.

(4) Needless to say that this order be not construed as an expression of opinion on merits of the controversy pending before learned trial Court in any manner.

(5) Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
