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SHEEL NAGU, C.J. (ORAL)

1. This petition invoking the inherent powers of this Court under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 has been filed by the complainant in FIR No. 61 dated 13.04.2024 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 302 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Pinangwa, District Nuh, Haryana raising the grievance that investigation is not being conducted in a free and fair manner and, therefore, the same may be transferred to an independent agency for conduction and conclusion.

2. The learned State counsel, after seeking instructions, informs that in the said FIR, which was registered on 13.04.2024, two accused, namely, Ikbal and Sahid were arrested on 15.04.2024 and 22.04.2024 respectively. Thereafter, charge-sheet against both the said accused was filed on 11.07.2024, while keeping further investigation pending under Section 173(8)



Cr.P.C. (Section 193 of the BNSS, 2023) against the other absconding co-accused.

3. In view of the above, the petitioner can always raise his grievance before the trial Court.

4. As regards further investigation against the absconding accused is concerned, the Police authorities are directed to expedite the investigation and conclude the same as early as possible.

5. The petition, accordingly, stands disposed of.
