By way of present petition filed under Section 482 Bharatiya
Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case
FIR (Annexure P-1) as under:

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in
compliance to the order dated 02.12.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner
has already joined the investigation and as such interim bail granted to the
petitioner may be confirmed.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions received from ASI



Pardeep has intimated that the petitioner has joined investigation and is no more required for any custodial investigation in this case nor he is required for further investigation.

4. Heard.

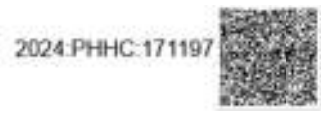
5. During the course of hearing on 02.12.2024, the following order was passed:-

“ 3. It is, inter alia, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has been nominated on the basis of disclosure statement made by co-accused Mahender from whom the alleged recovery of 7.5 grams of heroin has been effected. ASI Dalip Kumar, Investigating Officer of the case, present in Court, submits that apart from the disclosure statement (Annexure R-1) that there is nothing substantial against the petitioner.

4. Be it the case, without commenting on the merits, the petitioner is hereby directed to join investigation within seven days from today and in the event of his arrest, he is ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) of BNSS, 2023.

5. List on 19.12.2024.”

6. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 02.12.2024 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 02.12.2024 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will



influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

7. The petition stands allowed.
