By way of present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.569 dated 17.12.2021 registered under Section 379 IPC (later on Sections 467, 468, 471 and 34 IPC were added) at Police Station Civil Lines, Hisar, District Hisar.

Status report by way of affidavit of Shri Satyapal Yadav, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Detective, Hisar has been filed on behalf of the respondent- State.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that similarly placed co-accused Bhanwar Lal has since been allowed bail by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 29.03.2022 passed in CRM-M-2144 of 2022 (Annexure P.2).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that another co-accused Bansi Lal has been allowed bail by the Court of Sessions vide order dated 25.05.2022 as referred in the impugned order Annexure P.4. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner has also been released on bail in case FIR

No.148 dated 17.12.2021 registered under Sections 307, 332, 353, 467, 468, 471, 411 and 34 IPC as is referred in the status report.

Learned State Counsel could not refute the afore-said contentions. It is conceded that case of the petitioner is on the same footing as that of co-accused Bhanwar Lal who was allowed bail by co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide Annexure P.2

Having regard to the afore-said facts and circumstances of the case, particularly on the basis of parity, but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/ Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
