HARKESH MANUJA, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions from Mr. Shashi Gagg, Assistant Registrar (Legal), Office of DSE (SE), Punjab, Mohali, submits that the revised pension in terms of Sixth Pay Commission alongwith arrears w.e.f. 01.07.2024 shall be released in favour of the petitioners with effect from 01.12.2024.

[2] In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the present petition any further.

[3] Dismissed as not pressed.

[4] However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, as per undertaking, the petitioner(s) would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring / concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner(s) towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
