DEEPAK GUPTA, J. (ORAL)

[1] On 04.12.2023, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“By way of this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., prayer is made for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0176 datd 28.09.2023, under Sections 22/ 29 (Act No.61 of 1985) of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Garhshankar, District Hoshiarpur, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that on the basis of secret information to the effect that some persons were selling intoxicant injections, 11 persons were nabbed by the police and separate recoveries were effected from them. Learned counsel contends further that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and her name has surfaced only on the basis of the disclosure statement of co-accused, without specifying any role. Learned counsel contends further that petitioner is involved in three more cases of NDPS Act, but in two of the cases, she is on bail and in the third case, she was named alongwith 100 people of the village.

Notice of motion.

Mr. M.S. Nagra, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Copy of paper book be supplied to him during the course of day.

Adjourned to 12.02.2024 for filing status report.

In the meantime, petitioner is directed to join investigation and co-operate in the same. She will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court nor shall make any attempt to contact the complainant of the case or any witness associated with the case. In the

event of the arrest of the petitioner, she shall be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. She shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

[2] Today, learned State Counsel, has informed this Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation, in compliance of the order dated 04.12.2023 and is no longer required for further investigation.

[3] In view of the aforesaid, the order dated 04.12.2023, whereby the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail, is hereby made absolute. However, she shall continue to join investigation, if and so required by the Investigating Officer.
