Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.57 dated 28.05.2022 registered under Sections 409, 420, 120-B IPC at Police Station Dehlon, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.

In Para 12 of the petition, it has been averred that the petitioner is not involved in any other case and he has not been declared as proclaimed offender.

However, learned counsel for the State has produced Custody Certificate, which shows that the petitioner is involved in the following cases, which have been concealed in the present petition:-

1. FIR No.32 dated 17.03.2016 under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC, Police Station Malerkotla.
2. FIR No.05 dated 04.02.2018 under Sections 225-B, 120-B IPC, 7, 9, 13(i) D(iii) of Prevention of Corruption Act, Police Station Malerkotla.

3. *FIR No.31 dated 20.04.2018 under Section 420 IPC Police Station Malerkotla.*
4. *FIR No.84 dated 26.04.2010, under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act.*

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition.
