1. Prayer in the present writ petition is for directing the respondents to pay compensation to the petitioner due to unnatural death of the husband of the petitioner No.1 and on account of the injury received to petitioner No.2 which happened due to natural calamity of Sky lighting.

2. Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-State on instructions from Sudeep Singh, ADA, office of Deputy Commissioner, Nuh at Mewat, has submitted that the grievance espoused in the present writ petition does not survive any further since

the issue has already been examined by the Government and a decision



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had been taken. As per the notification dated 01.08.2023 passed by the Financial Commissioner, Revenue and Additional Chief Secretary to Govt. of Haryana, Department of Revenue and Disaster Management, a sum of Rs. 4 lacs became payable to Sanowar-petitioner No.1 while compensation for the disability suffered has to be separately assessed. He submits that letter bearing No. 787-FRA dated 09.05.2024 has already been sent by the Deputy Commissioner to the Divisional Commissioner, Faridabad Division and that the necessary ex-gratia compensation in terms of the policy decision bearing Memo No. 7769-ER-II-2023/4583 shall be released in favour of the petitioners expeditiously and preferably within a period of three months.

3. In view of the aforesaid statement, the present writ petition has been disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

4. Needless to mention that the requisite compensation as assessed under the policy shall be disbursed by the respondent-State within the time frame as undertaken today.
