Having argued the matter at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he be permitted to withdraw the petition to enable the petitioner to pursue the representations dated November 5, 2024 (P-7), the authorities have already been served with.

Served with the advance copy of the petition, Mr. Jastej Singh, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab is present in Court on behalf of the respondents. He submits that if indeed any such representations (**ibid**) are pending before the competent authority, the same shall be considered and dealt with at the earliest. And the necessary orders shall be passed thereon, in accordance with law, and communicated to the petitioner.

In the wake of the position sketched out above, and in terms of the statements made by learned counsel for the parties, the petition stands disposed of.

This Court is sanguine that the respondent-authorities shall consider the matter in the right earnest, and pass the appropriate orders within the time indicated by learned State counsel.

Needless to assert that this order shall not constitute any expression of opinion on the merits of the case of either party, for, as indicated



above, the competent authority shall examine the concerns/grievances of the petitioner, strictly in accordance with law.
