This writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* quashing impugned Memo No.11204PF-4056A dated 10.10.2023 (Annexure P-15) passed by Deputy Secretary (Establishment, GGSSTP, Roopnagar in response to legal notice dated 31.07.2023 (Annexure P-13).
