HARSH BUNGER J. (ORAL)

1. The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, seeking a writ in the nature of Certiorari for setting aside the recovery notices dated 30.10.2024 (Annexure P-17).
2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that against the order dated 22.07.2021 (Annexure P-16) passed under sub-section 2 of Section 53 of Haryana Panchayati Raj Act, 1994, remedy of appeal is provided under sub-section 3 of Section 53 of Haryana Panchayati Raj Act, 1994. Accordingly, he may be permitted to withdraw the present writ petitioner with liberty to the petitioner to avail his remedy of appeal as noticed above.
3. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
4. All pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
