1. The petitioner has filed this petition invoking the inherent powers of this Court under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 in FIR No. 298 dated 17.08.2024 under Sections 103(1), 126(2), 190 and 191(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS), 2023 registered at Police Station Hansi Sadar, District Hansi on account of the fact that the investigation is not being conducted in a free, fair and expeditious manner.
2. The petitioner has an alternative remedy under Section 156(3) of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Section 175 of BNSS) and Section 200 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Section 223 of BNSS) before the Magistrate of the area concerned which can very well be invoked by her.
3. With the aforesaid liberty, the petition stands disposed of.
