VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. This is a Civil Revision Petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India against the order dated 10.10.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Family Court, Ludhiana, vide which the application filed by the petitioner under Order 6 Rule 17 read with Section 151 CPC for amendment of the written statement has been dismissed.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that since the averments, on the basis of which the pleas are raised, have already been raised in the written statement, thus, he seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to raise all the pleas, which are available to her, during the course of trial. It is further submitted that the petitioner is ready to settle



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the matter and has prayed that the matter be referred for mediation.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent-husband has submitted that he has instructions to submit that there are no chances of settlement and thus, no purpose would be served by sending the matter for mediation.

4. Since the offer made on behalf of the petitioner has not been accepted by the respondent, thus, the matter cannot be referred to mediation, at this stage.

5. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to raise all the pleas, which are available to her, during the course of trial.
