1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for violating the order dated 21.08.2023 passed by this Court in CWP-18007-2023.
2. Affidavit of the respondent filed in the Registry is taken on record. Learned counsel for the respondent has submitted that the order dated 21.08.2023 passed by this Court in CWP-18007-2023 has been complied with and speaking order dated 19.12.2023 has been passed.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the same.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law, if he feels aggrieved of the order passed by the respondent.
