The instant petition has been preferred by the petitioner seeking issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release the amount of Rs.2,99,984/- in lieu of the products purchased by them vide GeM Contract No.GEMC511687757 104209 and GeM Contract No.GEMC511687774997826 dated 23.12.2020 (Annexure P-1 and P-2 respectively) along with interest @ 18% per annum.

2 At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, at this juncture, the petitioner would be satisfied in case the respondent-Authorities are directed to look into the legal notice dated 21.02.2023 (Annexure P-8) sent by the petitioner and the grievance

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espoused by the petitioner therein and a speaking order is passed thereupon in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

3 Notice of motion.

4 On the asking of the Court, Mr. Pankaj Mulwani, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1, 2 and 4 to 6 and Mr. Vivek Saini, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.3/Municipal Committee, Indri, District Karnal, and they submit that they have no objection to the aforesaid prayer being granted.

5 Accordingly, with the consent of the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of and respondent No.3 - the Executive Officer-cum-Secretary, Municipal Committee, Indri, District Karnal, is directed to take note of the legal notice dated 21.02.2023 (Annexure P-8) sent by the petitioner and to pass a reasoned and speaking order thereupon in accordance with law preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

6 Needless to mention that in the event the entitlement of the petitioner being established as per law, the payment due to the petitioner shall be released expeditiously and preferably within a further period of three months.

7 In the event of non-payment of dues within the said period, the same shall be released along with interest @ 6% per annum from the date of filing of the present petition to be paid to the petitioner and further subject

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to additional payment of a cost of Rs.50,000/- to be deposited with the PGI Poor Patients’ Welfare Fund, Chandigarh. The said additional financial liability of accrued interest and cost shall be subject to recovery from the erring officials.

8 Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
