KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(Oral)

1. The indolent and non-decisive act of respondents no.4-District Magistrate, Moga, has caused grievances to the present petitioner, and propelled her to approach this Court by invoking the writ jurisdiction as envisaged under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, thereby seeking a *mandamus* upon the official respondents to take a final decision upon the application bearing No.6589, dated 12.09.2024, for parole for 8 weeks moved by her husband. He seeks that the necessary direction be passed upon the competent authority to decide the application (*supra*).

2. Without going into the veracity of the allegations, as alleged in the instant petition, considering the *bona fide* prayer of the present petitioner, this Court passes a *mandamus* upon the competent authority

amongst the respondents, to take a final decision on the application (*supra*), within a period of 10 days from today.
