The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to direct the concerned Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Mohali, to decide the pending bail application moved by the petitioner in case FIR No.233 under Section 406, 420, 465, 467, 468 and 471 of IPC registered at P.S. City Kharar dated 14.08.2023.
