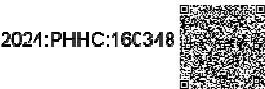

1. Instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in case FIR No.315 dated 07.11.2022 under Sections 307, 341, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Civil Line, Batala, Tehsil and District Batala (Gurdaspur).

2. In the headnote, it is mentioned to be the first petition seeking regular bail. The office has reported that as a matter of fact, this is not the first regular bail application and is the third petition on behalf of the same petitioner seeking regular bail in the same FIR as the petitioner had earlier filed CRM-M-20205 of 2024 (Feroz alias Feroz Deen alias Firoz alias Firozdin v. State of Punjab), which was withdrawn by the petitioner on 30.04.2024. Thereafter, another petition bearing CRM-M-30973 of 2024 (Feroz @ Feroz Deen @ Feroz @



Firozdin v. State of Punjab) was filed by the petitioner, wherein vide order dated 05.07.2024, it was observed as under: -

“In Para 12 of the petition, it has been stated by the petitioner that he was never declared as proclaimed offender in the present case at any stage. The said averment is wrong as it has been recorded by the Court of learned Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur while rejecting the bail filed by the petitioner in its order dated 10.04.2024 that the petitioner was declared proclaimed offender.

Counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.”

- 3. Now the present third petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking regular bail, mentioning the same as first petition.
- 4. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition.
- 5. Dismissed as withdrawn.
