1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 11.09.2023 passed in CWP-19884-2023.
2. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 11.09.2023 passed in CWP-19884-2023 has been complied with and speaking order dated 26.02.2024 has been passed, vide which the petitioners were not found entitled to any benefit. Copy of the order dated 26.02.2024, produced by the counsel for the respondents, in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
4. However, the petitioners would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law, if they feel aggrieved of the order passed by the respondent concerned.
