Main case

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents for willful disobedience of order dated 12.10.2023, passed by this Court in CWP 23230-2023.
2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the order qua which the contempt is alleged has since been complied with. Therefore, the present petition is rendered infructuous. However, the petitioner would be permitted to file an appeal, in accordance with law.
3. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous with liberty aforesaid.
