Prayer has been made by the petitioner for quashing of order dated 01.07.2024 whereby his bail was cancelled and bonds were forfeited to the State and nonailable warrants has been issued against him in case arising out of FIR No.108 dated 07.06.2022 under Sections 21 of Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Samralla, District Khanna.

2 It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the case was pending for 01.07.2024 and then the next date of hearing was fixed as 09.12.2024. However due to typing mistake, the case had been shown to be adjourned for 07.09.2024 which mistake had been corrected by the learned trial Court. It is also submitted that the absence of the petitioner on 01.07.2024 was not intentional but due to the reason that wrong next date of



the case had been noted. Since he is ready join the proceedings and the ultimate aim is to ensure timely disposal of the cases before the learned trial Court and to abide by terms and conditions to be imposed upon him, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to surrender before the learned trial Court within a period of one week and on doing so and on moving appropriate application, the learned trial Court shall admit him to bail subject to his furnishing personal as well as surety bonds to its satisfaction. However, this petition shall be deemed to be dismissed if the petitioner does not abide by this order.

Petition stands disposed of.
