**RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (ORAL)**

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 2(b) read with Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for violating the order dated 21.12.2022 passed by this Court in CWP-29486-2022.
2. Short reply by way of affidavit of Pardeep Singh Dhillon, Secretary, Regional Transport Authority, Patiala has been filed by learned State counsel today in the Court. The same is taken on record. Learned State counsel has submitted that the order dated 21.12.2022 passed by this Court in CWP-29486-2022 has been complied with and the application moved by the petitioner stands rejected, vide order dated 12.01.2024.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the same.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
