SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

1. The petitioner, who has no criminal antecedents and is in custody since 22.08.2024 for the offences of cheating and criminal conspiracy, has filed this petition for grant of regular bail in FIR No. 37 dated 29.04.2024 under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Cyber Crime, District Karnal, arising out of an incident where the petitioner being a middleman struck prospective and perspective contract for purchase of rice.

2. It is submitted that consideration of the transaction was made in the bank account of potential seller, who is not the petitioner.

3. The allegations appear to have civil overtones. Considering the period of custody undergone by the petitioner and the fact that he has no criminal antecedents, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to



his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- with two sureties, in the like amount, to the satisfaction of the Illaqa/Duty Magistrate, subject to the condition that he shall plant 10 saplings of indigenous plants at a public place and submit proof in that regard by way of photographs before the trial court within a period of 15 days and if there is no such intimation submitted or intimation is found to be incorrect, then the State can move an application for cancellation of bail of the petitioner.

4. The petition stands allowed.
