1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondents for disobedience of order dated 09.08.2023 passed by this Court in CWP-17261-2023.
2. Reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Prem Chand, Executive Engineer, Punjab Heritage & Tourism Promotion Board, on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 has been filed by learned State counsel today in the Court. The same is taken on record. Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that the order dated 09.08.2023 passed by this Court in CWP-17261-2023 has been complied with and speaking order dated 29.12.2023 has been passed.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the same.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law, if he feels aggrieved of the order passed by the respondents.
