The instant petition has been instituted under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondent No.2 to issue the dependent certificate of Ex-Service Man in terms of policy dated 09.03.2022 (Annexure P-5) as father of the petitioner had retired/discharged from Indian Army on 14.08.1969.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with regard to his grievance, he has submitted representation dated 02.11.2023 (Annexure P-3) to the respondent-authorities but no action has been taken by them till date.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Suneel Ranga, DAG, Haryana appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, submits that at this juncture, he would be satisfied if respondent No.2-Secretary, District Sainik



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and Ardh Sainik Welfare Department, Kaithal is directed to consider and decide the representation dated 02.11.2023 (Annexure P-3) in a time bound manner.

Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of respondent-State does not oppose the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Accordingly, in view of the above, with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of while directing respondent No.2-Secretary, District Sainik and Ardh Sainik Welfare Department, Kaithal to consider and decide the representation dated 02.11.2023 (Annexure P-3) by passing a reasoned and speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
