SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

1. The petitioner has filed this petition for grant of regular bail in FIR No. 222 dated 14.08.2020 under Sections 22, 25, 29 and 61 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Division A, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has undergone custody of about two years and is in custody since 14.08.2022 in another case of similar nature.

3. In the instant case, 66000 tablets of Tramadol were recovered from the petitioner. The petitioner has four cases of similar nature against him, constituting his criminal antecedents.

4. Learned State counsel informs that all the prosecution witnesses have been examined and case is fixed for adducing defence evidence.



5. Considering the fact that the petitioner has repeatedly committed similar nature of offences, it would be appropriate that trial in this case is allowed to be concluded.
6. Accordingly, the petition stands dismissed for the time being, with liberty to the petitioner to re-visit the Court for grant of bail, if the trial gets further delayed.
