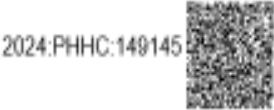

1. The petitioner by filing the instant petition under Section 483 of the BNSS, 2023, is making a prayer for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.69 dated 05.07.2024, under Sections 21 and 22 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Lambran, District Jalandhar.
2. The petitioner is stated to be involved in three other cases under the NDPS Act. The recovery, which has been effected in the instant case, falls within the ambit of commercial quantity, therefore, considering the days of incarceration, which is 04 months and 07 days, and the recovery effected from the present petitioner, and the antecedents of the present petitioner, this Court is not inclined to grant asked for relief of regular bail, the instant petition is dismissed.



3. In the instant petition, the petitioner has also made a prayer for grant of interim bail on account of marriage of the daughter of the petitioner. The instant prayer has been made without availing the alternate remedies as available to the petitioner, at first instance, therefore, the petitioner is relegated to the Court concerned for the asked for relief of interim bail.
