SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

1. The petitioner has filed this petition invoking the inherent powers of this Court under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 in FIR No. 111 dated 27.07.2024 under Sections 21, 23, 29, 61, 85 of the NDPS Act, 1985 (lateron Section 25, 54, 59 Arms Act was added), registered at Police Station Special Task Force, District SAS Nagar, on account of the fact that the investigation is not being conducted in a free, fair and expeditious manner.
2. The petitioner has an alternative remedy under Section 156(3) of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Section 175 of BNSS) and Section 200 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Section 223 of BNSS) before the Magistrate of the area concerned which can very well be invoked by her.
3. With the aforesaid liberty, the petition stands disposed of.
