1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the order dated 26.09.2019 (Annexure P-3).
2. On 15.11.2023, none had appeared on behalf of the petitioners.
3. On 20.05.2024, none had appeared on behalf of the petitioners and the following order was passed:-

“On 10.01.2020, a Coordinate Bench of this Court was pleased to pass the following order:-
