On 07.12.2023 the following order was passed:-

“ *The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for setting aside the order dated 15.11.2023 (Annexure P-1) vide which the arrest warrants of the petitioner have been issued in FIR No.135 dated 13.11.2021 under Section 379-B, 34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Sadar Moga, District Moga.*

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that on account of noting down of a wrong date, the petitioner was not able to appear before the Trial Court on 15.11.2023, on which date, the impugned order came to be passed. He states that the petitioner is ready and willing to join the proceedings once again.

Notice of motion for 05.02.2024.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to

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surrender before the Trial Court within a period of one week from today and subject to a deposit of Rs.25,000/- as costs with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Bar Association, Chandigarh Lawyers Family Welfare Fund, Account No.41564846387, SBI High Court Branch, IFSC:-SBIN0050306, he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The learned counsel for the petitioner shall produce the receipt regarding deposit of Rs. 25,000/- with the aforesaid Association as well as a copy of the order granting interim bail to the petitioner on the next date of hearing”.

On 20.12.2023 the following order was passed:-

“ **CRM-53293 of 2023**

The present application has been filed by the applicant-petitioner for placing on record the account statement and application dated 14.12.2023.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and the account statement and application dated 14.12.2023 are taken on record.

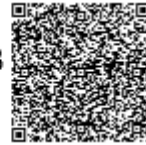
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The present application has been filed by the applicant-petitioner for extension of time to furnish the bail bonds pursuant to the order passed by this Court on 07.12.2023.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and one week more time is granted to the applicant/petitioner to comply with the order dated

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07.12.2023 passed by this Court”.

The Counsel for the petitioner contends that in compliance of the aforementioned order the petitioner has surrendered and has since been granted the concession of interim bail on 22.12.2023. He has also deposited the costs as imposed by this Court vide order dated 07.12.2023.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

Disposed of.

However, it is made clear that the petitioner shall continue to appear before the Trial Court and shall not absent himself without any sufficient cause.
