The instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.107 dated 17.09.2023, under Sections 307, 148, 149 and 120-B of the IPC, 1860 and Section 25, 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Nakodar Sadar, District Jalandhar (Rural).

This Court vide order dated 07.12.2023, while issuing notice of motion, granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner, subject to his joining the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 07.12.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Manjit Singh, does not controvert the said fact and further submits that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

In view of the above, the order dated 07.12.2023 is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
