1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for punishing the respondents for disobedience of order dated 28.07.2023 passed by Division Bench of this Court in CWP-16210-2023.
2. Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that the order dated 28.07.2023 passed by this Court in CWP-16210-2023 has been complied with. Learned counsel has filed copy of speaking order dated 12.01.2024, vide which, representation of the petitioners stand decided. Copy of speaking order is taken on record.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners does not dispute the same.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, the petitioners would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law, if they feel aggrieved of the order passed by the respondents.
