The petitioner (M/s Khairwal Developers Pvt. Ltd.) has prayed for
the following substantive relief:

“Civil Writ Petition under Article 226 of the
Constitution of India for the issuance of a Writ in the
nature of Mandamus for issuance of directions to the
respondents no.1 to 3 to allot the work/tender for the
Management, Maintenance and Operation of Nature
Camp at Masani Barrage, Rewari (Haryana) as the
petitioner firm has been declared successful in the tender
process as per the report dated 19.04.2022 (P-2) of the
Tender Evaluation Committee, however, the respondents
are delaying the allotment of work without any legal
justification to the petitioner firm and also thereby
causing loss to the Government revenue.

AND

For issuance of the writ in the nature of certiorari
pertaining to the impugned action on the part of
respondent no.5, who orally informing the petitioner
firm that the tender has been cancelled, however not
passed any order nor supplying any document regarding
the cancellation of the tender, which has been



allotted/recommended in favour of the petitioner firm on the basis of highest combine score by the Tender Evaluation Committee.”

Having argued the matter at length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits, for the respondents are still in *seisin* of the dispute, he be permitted to withdraw the petition to enable the petitioner to pursue the matter with the authorities as regards its concerns/grievances, in the first instance.

Accordingly, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty prayed for.
