1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for violating the order dated 29.10.2019 passed by this Court in CWP-9253-2019.
2. Learned counsel for the respondents has supplied copy of speaking order dated 01.01.2024 passed by the respondent and has submitted that the order dated 29.10.2019 passed by this Court in CWP-9253-2019 has been complied with. Copy of speaking order is taken on record.
