SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

1. The petitioner, who is in custody since 01.07.2023, is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 50 dated 30.01.2023 under Sections 379-B, 341, 201 IPC and Section 27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station City Sector 13-17, Panipat.
2. The petitioner is alleged with theft of car by exercising force, which *prima facie* appears to be a case of robbery, but for reasons best known to the prosecution, it has been registered as snatching under Section 379-B IPC.
3. The petitioner is in custody for more than one year and five months and has large number of cases of similar nature registered against him in the recent past.
4. Though out of 20 enlisted prosecution witnesses, only one has been examined, but considering antecedents of the petitioner and his



involvement in the crime, his release on bail would be at the risk of allowing him to flee from justice.

5. Accordingly, the petition stands dismissed.
