1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for violating the order dated 04.08.2023 passed by this Court in CWP-16869-2023.
2. Compliance affidavit of Charanjot Singh Walia, SDM Sangrur on behalf of respondent No.2 filed by learned counsel for the respondents today in the Court is taken on record. Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that the order dated 04.08.2023 passed by this Court in CWP-16869-2023 has been complied with and order dated 27.12.2023 has been passed.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the same.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law, if he feels aggrieved of the order passed by the respondents.
