The prayer in the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for the grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.69 dated 13.05.2021 registered under Sections 420, 120-B IPC and Section 13 of Punjab Travel Professionals Act, 2014 at Police Station Mullanpur, District SAS Nagar.

A status report dated 05.01.2024 by way of an affidavit of Dharamvir Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Kharar-2 District SAS Nagar has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record.
