1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 27.03.2023 passed in CWP-2346-2017.

2. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 27.03.2023 passed in CWP-2346-2017 has been complied with and speaking order dated 13.02.2024 has been passed. Copy of the order dated 13.02.2024 (in vernacular) produced by the counsel for the respondents in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.

3. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.



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4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-redressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
