1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking directions to respondents to decide his representation dated 12.09.2023 (Annexure P-4).
2. The petitioner is working with respondent-department as Head Constable. He was posted at Hoshiarpur which falls within Jalandhar Range and on account of promotion, he has been transferred to Ropar Range and has been allocated District Mohali.
