By way of present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.0732, dated 24.12.2019 registered under Section 346 IPC (later on during investigation Sections 148, 149, 201, 302, 328, 396 IPC added and Section 346 IPC deleted) at Police Station Quilla Panipat, District Panipat.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that similarly placed co-accused Parsu Ram alias Paras has already been allowed bail by this Court vide order dated 05.05.2023 passed in CRM-M-40713 of 2022 (Annexure P.3). Learned counsel also points out that petitioner is in custody for the last more than 04 years.

Learned State Counsel could not refute the afore-said contention to the effect that the case of the petitioner is on same footing as that of Parsu Ram alias Paras, who has already been allowed bail by this Court vide order dated 05.05.2023 passed in CRM-M-40713 of 2022 (Annexure P.3).

Apart from above, custody certificate placed on record reveals that the petitioner is in custody for the last 04 years 01 month and 07 days.

Having regard to all the afore-said facts and circumstances, particularly on the basis of parity, but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, present petition is allowed. Petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/ Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
