1. Petitioner Jatinder Singh alias Nikku has filed petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 202 dated 24.09.2024, under Section 331(6), 115(2), 3(5) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, registered at Police Station City-1 Abohar, District Fazilka.

2. On filing of present anticipatory bail petition, vide order dated 14.11.2024, arrest of present petitioner was stayed, subject to his joining of investigation.

3. Learned counsel for petitioner pointed out that in pursuance of aforesaid order dated 14.11.2024, petitioner has already joined investigation and he is still ready and willing to join as and when required.

4. Status report is filed, which is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions. As per status report, it is confirmed that petitioner has joined investigation on 07.12.2024 and he has got recovered *Danda* allegedly used in commission of crime. Learned counsel representing State

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on instructions from HC Bhupender Singh, No. 367/FZK confirmed that petitioner is not required for any other purpose.

5. Considering the aforesaid factual position, anticipatory bail petition filed by petitioner – Jatinder Singh alias Nikku is allowed. He be not arrested. In case of his arrest, he be released on bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer concerned, subject to condition that petitioner will join investigation as and when required. He will not tamper with or interfere with investigation and will not leave country without prior permission as provided under Section 482(2) of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.

6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
