NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to release the service benefits such as gratuity and leave encashment to the petitioner along with interest on the delayed payment.
2. Learned counsel for respondent No.3 submits that payment of leave encashment amounting to Rs.1,86,553/- is admissible to the petitioner and the cheque of the said amount shall be sent to the petitioner by registered post within a period of 01 week from today.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition, with regard to the claim of the petitioner regarding gratuity, to enable him to avail other legal remedy, in accordance with law.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
