1. Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioner has approached this Court by way of instant Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No.2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner, at the hands of respondent No.4.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 08.11.2024 (Annexure P-2) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Gurdaspur and she shall be satisfied in case respondent No.2 is directed to look into the representation dated 08.11.2024 (Annexure P-2) and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.

3. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only, at this stage.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. I.P.S. Sabharwal, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3-State.



5. Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and after going through the case file, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Gurdaspur-respondent No.2 to consider the representation dated 08.11.2024 (Annexure P-2) and decide the same by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly as per law, within a period of two weeks from today.
