Present application has been filed for recalling the order dated 19.12.2023, by which, the present petition was dismissed for non-prosecution.

Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. He raises no objection for the grant of prayer as raised in the present application.

Keeping in view the averments made in the application, which is duly supported by an affidavit, coupled with the fact that learned

counsel for the respondents has not objected to the relief as prayed in the present application, the same is allowed. The order dated 19.12.2023 is recalled and the writ petition is restored to its original number and status.

The present petition is disposed of having been not pressed qua petitioners No. 3 and 5 with liberty to them to avail appropriate remedy against any order, which has been passed during the pendency of the present writ petition. Liberty is also granted to the petitioners to approach the respondents by way of representation in case that satisfies the petitioners.
