1. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondents on instructions, submits that the arrears of pay scale for a period of 38 months prior to the filing of the writ petition shall be released in favour of the petitioner in pursuance to the order passed in LPA-2132-2024 within a period of two weeks from today.

2. In view of the aforesaid stand taken by learned counsel for the respondents, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.

3. Dismissed as not pressed. Rule discharged.

However, in case the needful is not done within the aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring/concerned Officer would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
