1. The petitioner has approached this Court through instant writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India directing respondent No.2 – Appellate Authority to decide the statutory appeal dated 22.10.2024 (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioner against the punishment order dated 09.10.2024 (Annexure P-1) in a time-bound manner and for direction to respondent No.1 not to effect recovery from the salary of the petitioner during the pendency of statutory appeal dated 22.10.2024.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for deciding the statutory appeal filed by the petitioner dated 22.10.2024 (Annexure P-2) expeditiously by passing a speaking order in a time-bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.



4. Mr. Manbir Singh Batth, Advocate, has appeared and accepted notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that the appeal filed by the petitioner shall be decided expeditiously.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record of the case.

In view of the aforesaid stand of the learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition is disposed of with directions that the statutory appeal dated 22.10.2024 (Annexure P-2) pending before the Appellate Authority shall be decided within a period of six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Further recovery from the petitioner shall remain stayed and would be subject to the final order that may be passed by the Appellate Authority.

7. The petition stands disposed of.
