In the event of arrest, he shall be admitted to interim bail on furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

3. Today, the learned State counsel on instructions imparted to him by ASI Hardev Singh, submits that the petitioner has already joined the investigation and he is fully co-operating with the investigation process and he is not required for any further custodial investigation.

4. In view of the specific stand taken by the learned State counsel, the present petition is **allowed** and order dated 18.12.2023 is, hereby, made absolute.
