1. After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the instant petition but has requested that since the petitioners are ready to appear before the Trial Court as such in that event, learned Trial Court may be directed to dispose of their bail application in an expeditious manner preferably within two weeks.

2. In view of his statement, instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn. However, in the event of the petitioners surrendering before the Trial Court within 07 days from today, learned Trial Court is directed to dispose of the bail application, if so moved by the petitioners, in an expeditious manner preferably within a period of two weeks in accordance with law.
