This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 read with Section 14 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for disobeying the orders dated 20.02.2015 and 06.02.2017 passed by Division Bench of this Court.

Counter reply on behalf of the respondent filed in the Registry is taken on record. The reply and the communication (Annexure R-3) sent by the Union Public Service Commission to the Chandigarh Administration shows that the petitioner has duly been considered for the selection in question pursuant to the High Court order. Though, the petitioner has not been found suitable for selection by the UPSC, however, there is no more any violation of the order of the High Court as such.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.

However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-redressed, she would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
